Coal-handling capacity of Mormugao Port

Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of coal-handling capacity of the major and minor ports in the country including the Mormugao port, year-wise during the last five years;
- (b) the details of the planned capacity of the Mormugao port; and
- (c) the cost of the expansion project of Mormugao port including the details of its sanction and tender and the time by which it is likely to get completed?

(a): Coal handling capacity of Mormugao Port, year-wise during the last five years, is tabulated below:
