OPERATIONS OF FLIGHTS FROM MANPUR AIRSTRIP

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION नागर विमानन मंत्री

be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether any airlines company has submitted a proposal to operate flights from Manpur airstrip to different parts of the country including Rajasthan under UDAN scheme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the reasons for delay in starting air service from Manpur airstrip under Regional Connectivity Scheme?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Manpur airstrip in Rajasthan is available in the list of unserved airports in Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) - UDAN document. No bid to operate flight to/from Manpur airstrip has been received till the completion of four rounds of bidding under UDAN.

UDAN is a market driven scheme where bidding rounds are conducted from time to time to cover more destinations/stations and routes. Based on their assessment of demand on particular routes, interested airlines submit their proposals connecting the RCS Airports at the time of bidding under UDAN.
