Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Child Protection Committees have been formed at the Gram Panchayat/Block/District/State levels in various States including Odisha;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether Union Government has been giving any assistance to States for functioning of such Committees and if so, the details thereof and the criteria fixed for such assistance:
- (d) the details of funds allocated, released and utilized by various States during each of the last three years, State/UT-wise; and
- (e) whether there is any proposal to enhance the quantum of remuneration and the other emolument of the staff engaged under the Mission Vatsalya and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) to (c): As per Mission Vatsalya guidelines, under the existing Standing/Sub-Committee system of the local bodies, the function of child welfare and protection issues may be assigned to the existing committee of the Urban Local Body/Panchayati Raj Institution/Gram Panchayat which deals with issues of social justice/welfare of women and children.
- (d): The State/UT-wise details of funds released and utilized by various States/UTs under Mission Vatsalya/Child Protection Scheme during each of the last three years is at **Annexure-I.**
- (e): Under Mission Vatsalya Scheme, remuneration of the staff engaged has been increased @ 32.4 % with effect from 1st April, 2022 and Annual rise in remuneration @ 3% (on cumulative basis) based on satisfactory performance from FY 2023-24 to FY 2025-26.
