- (a): Ministry of MSME, through Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), implements various Khadi and Village Industries (KVI) schemes and programmes for the development of KVI activities and to provide employment opportunities to the rural youths in the country including Rajasthan. Year-wise targets of KVI schemes/programmes in Rajasthan during last three years and current year is placed at **Annexure**.
- (b) & (c): Yes Sir, Ministry of MSME, through the Science and Technology (S&T) scheme of KVIC, is implementing Research & Development and Technology Dissemination programmes to enhance the quality of KVI products, increase the productivity and earning of artisans, reduction of drudgery, development of new products and diversification, as per market demand, efficient use of local raw material, etc.
