- a) Details of awards won by MoRTH during last 5 years are annexed.**
- b) Various innovative materials and technology such as cement treated sub-base & cement treated base courses, steel slag, waste plastic, recycled asphalt pavement, geo synthetics, ultra high fiber reinforced concrete, etc. are being used in construction of National Highways to expedite pace of construction and build durable infrastructure.**
- (c) As per the latest Basic Roads Statistics report, India has a network of about 63,31,757 kilometres of roads as of 31st March 2019, which is the second largest in the world, after the United States with 66,45,709 kilometres of roads.**
- (d) Length of National Highways (in km) increased during last 5 years and current year is as under.**

(e) New Districts are added by the State Governments from time to time. 30 districts were not connected by NHs as per the analysis done by the department in 2020 based on the list of districts available at that time. Out of those 30 districts, 28 districts have been further connected by NHs and 2 districts from that list are till not connected.
