UPGRADATION OF AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL TOWER

be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government is aware of need and importance for upgradation of existing Air Traffic Control Tower (ATC) facility at Kozhikode Airport;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the action taken regarding upgradation of the ATC facility at Kozhikode Airport;
- (c) whether the Government has any plans to increase the staff strength in the ATC department at Kozhikode Airport and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government has any plans to install the Primary Radar system at Kozhikode Airport and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. The Kozhikode Airport is operational with Aerodrome Control (ADC) and Surveillance based Approach Control (APP-S) units. The existing Air Traffic Control (ATC) Tower cum Technical block is more than 30 years old. To support the proposed airport expansion plan and modernisation of the airport, a new ATC tower meeting the international standards has been planned at Kozhikode International Airport along with the Technical Block.
- (c): The Kozhikode Airport has a sufficient number of Air Traffic Control (ATC) personnel assigned in accordance with its operational requirements. (d): No such proposal is presently under consideration.
