REPAIR OF EMBANKMENTS

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

(a) the details of funds allocated and sanctioned for repairing embankments since 2014, year-wise;

(b) the total length of new embankments built-in kilometers since 2014, year-wise; and

(c) the status of the master plans being outlined by the Brahmaputra Board for Manu and Howrah

rivers in Tripura along with the details of the timeline for the notification?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Flood management including erosion control falls within the purview of the States. Flood management and anti-erosion projects are formulated and implemented by concerned State Governments from own resources as per their priority. The Union Government supplements the efforts of the States by providing technical guidance and also promotional financial assistance for management of floods in critical areas.

To strengthen the structural measures of flood management, Ministry had implemented Flood Management Programme (FMP) during XI & XII Plan for providing Central Assistance to States for works related to flood control, anti-erosion, drainage development, anti-sea erosion, etc. which subsequently continued as a component of Flood Management and Border Areas Programme (FMBAP) for the period from 2017-18 to 2020-21 and further extended up to September 2022 with limited outlay. No central assistance is provided for repair and maintenance of embankments under the FMBAP scheme. However, projects for raising and strengthening of the embankment is not maintained centrally.

State wise details of funds released for various flood management projects under FMBAP scheme since year 2014 is at **Annexure**.

(c) Master plans of Manu River and Howrah river of Tripura were prepared by Brahmaputra Board and approved by Government of India in 2004. Periodic updation of master plans are taken up by Brahmaputra Board. Updation of master plan of Howrah river has been taken up by Brahmaputra Board in March 2022.
