### INCENTIVES FOR PMAY-U NO.2418. SHRIMATI GODDETI MADHAVI:

#### Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to give more incentives for Pradhan
  Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to increase unit area under PMAY-U as inflation is rising and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

#### ANSWER

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a) to (c) The 'Land' and 'Colonisation' are State subject. The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) under "Housing for All" Mission since June 2015 by providing Central assistance to supplement efforts of States/ Union Territories (UTs) for providing all weather 'pucca' houses with basic civic services to all eligible urban beneficiaries. PMAY-U covers all statutory towns as per Census 2011 and towns notified subsequently including Notified Planning / Development Areas. The scheme is being implemented through four verticals, i.e., Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC); Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP); In-Situ Slum Redevelopment (ISSR) and Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS) based on eligibility criteria as per scheme guidelines.

Based on the project proposals submitted by States/ UTs, as on 24.07.2023, 118.90 lakh houses have been sanctioned under PMAY-U, out of which 112.25 lakh have been grounded for construction; of which 75.51 lakh had been completed and delivered to beneficiaries.

PMAY-U, which was earlier upto 31.03.2022, has since been extended upto 31.12.2024, except CLSS vertical, to complete all the sanctioned houses without changing the funding pattern and implementation methodology.
