FOUR LANING OF HIGHWAYS

2441. SHRI TOKHEHO YEPTHOMI: SHRI T.R.V.S. RAMESH: DR. VISHNU PRASAD M.K.:

> Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS सड़क परिवहन और राजमार्ग मंत्री

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the targets for converting of National Highways (NHs) into four and six lanes have been achieved during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the total length of NHs targeted to be converted into four lanes and six lanes during each of the last three financial years and the current financial year, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the total length of NHs that have actually been converted into four lanes and six lanes during the said period, State-wise/UT-wise and stretch-wise;
- (d) the funds earmarked/allocated/spent for the said purpose during the said period;
- (e) the time by which four laning of NH-29 between Dimapur-Kohima is likely to be completed and the funds released so far in this regard; and
- (f) whether the said project is as per schedule and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) to (c) The Ministry sets targets for construction of National Highways (NHs) on linear length basis and not on lane-km basis. However, progress of construction of four-lane, six-lane etc., is monitored. The details of targets and achievements for construction of NHs during each of last three financial years and the current financial year (upto June'2023) State/UT-wise are annexed and overall year-wise summary in the country is as under:

(e)&(f) Four-laning is completed in 12.9 km and taken up in 42.86 km length, out of total approximate length of 75 km of Dimapur-Kohima section of NH-29. Out of this 42.86 km length, 28.65 km length is targeted for completion by August'2023 and the remaining length is targeted for completion by August'2025. The total expenditure incurred till date on four-laning of 42.86 km length is approximately Rs. 1215 crore. The main reasons for delay in completion are Contractor's default and COVID-19 pandemic.
