**(a) and (b) As per the Union Budget, 2022-23, budgetary allocation to NHAI for Asset monetisation through ToT mode was Rs. 10,000 crore. The amount remains the same as per the budget for current financial year. In 2022-23, the total asset monetisation proceeds, including ToT, InvIT and Securitisation, amounted to Rs. 16,133 crore. For financial year 2023-24, NHAI has identified about 46 road stretches for asset monetisation on TOT/InvIT mode (displayed on NHAI website) to allow bidders to proactively undertake their due diligence.**
