TAP WATER CONNECTIONS**

**NO. 2497. SHRI RAMESH CHANDRA MAJHI:**

**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of the works carried out under Jal Jeevan Mission-Urban (JJM-U) in the country, State/ UT-wise including Odisha during the last three years and the current year;**
- (b) the percentage of urban households have tap water connections in the country during the said period, State-wise;**
- (c) the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilised for the said works during the last three years; and**
- (d) the number of households to whom tap water has been provided/yet to be provided through the said Mission in Nabarangpur and Malkangiri Parliamentary Constituencies?**

**ANSWER**

**(a): The Jal Jeevan Mission (Urban) has been launched as Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0 on 01 October 2021 for a period of 05 years i.e., from the financial year 2021-22 to 2025-26. The Mission aims at making the cities 'water secure' and provide universal coverage of water supply through functional taps to all households in all the statutory towns in the country. Mission also aims at providing sewage/ septage management to all households of 500 cities covered in first phase of the AMRUT scheme.**

**For the State of Odisha, ₹1,373 crore has been allocated as Central Assistance (CA) for implementation of projects under AMRUT 2.0. So far, 147 projects worth ₹2,923.10 crore (*including Operation & Maintenance cost*) with committed CA ₹1,146.51 crore have been approved by the Apex Committee at Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA). Of these, Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) have been prepared for 76 projects worth ₹1,075 crore (capex cost), of these Notice Inviting Tenders (NITs) have been issued for 70 projects worth ₹966 crore & of these 61 projects worth ₹858 crore are in progress & 4 projects worth ₹16 crore have been completed.**

**(b): State-wise percentage of urban households with tap water connections in the country as on 2021 is placed at ANNEXURE-I.**

**It is also informed that tap water connections have also been provided through AMRUT Mission, which got subsumed under AMRUT 2.0, under which central assistance for ongoing and eligible projects of AMRUT shall be provided till 31 March, 2024. State-wise details of tap connections provided through AMRUT Mission is at ANNEXURE-II.**

**(c): Under AMRUT 2.0, Central funds for the States/ Union Territories have been sanctioned/ allocated for the entire mission period State Water Action Plan (SWAP)-wise and not year-wise/ project-wise. The total CA allocated for all the States/ Union Territory (UT) under AMRUT 2.0 is ₹66,750 crore for projects. During the last three years including the current year, CA worth ₹6,194 crore has been released for projects against which utilisation certificates of worth ₹217.44 crore have been received.**

**(d): No city was covered under AMRUT Mission in Nabrangpur and Malkangiri Parliamentary Constituencies. However, under AMRUT 2.0, 8 cities (Umarkote (NAC), Nabarangapur (M), Kotpad (NAC), Koraput (NAC), Jeypur (M), Sunabeda (NAC), Malkangiri (NAC) and Balimela (NAC)) are covered in Nabrangpur and Malkangiri Parliamentary Constituencies.**

**AMRUT 2.0 empowers States/ UTs to select the projects, define their scope of works and implement the projects in respective Urban Local Bodies (ULBs). States / Uts have been given freedom to design, approve and implement the projects in respective ULBs. So far, 4 water supply projects worth ₹147.90 cr have been approved by Apex committee in four cities of Jeypur, Koraput, Kotpad & Balimela in the said parliamentary constituencies. Through these projects 9,701 new water tap connections are planned to be provided & 12,495 existing household tap connections are planned to be serviced.**
