Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken by the Government to promote Mission Vatsalya;
- (b) the number of children registered under the said Mission, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the details of the breastfeeding counselling centres, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) : Ministry of Women and Child Development is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme namely 'Mission Vatsalya' (erstwhile Child Protection Services Scheme), through the State/ UT Governments on cost sharing basis between the Central and the State Governments for delivering services for children in difficult circumstances which include institutional care and non-institutional care services. The Government is committed to provide security net of statutory and service delivery structures to the children in need of care and protection and children in conflict with law. The Child Care Institutions (CCIs) established under the Mission Vatsalya scheme support *inter-alia* age-appropriate education, access to vocational training, recreation, health care, counselling etc. Support under non-institutional care is provided by way of sponsorship, foster care and after care to children in need of care and protection. The Ministry has issued Guidelines to the States/UTs on 05.07.2022 for implementation of Mission Vatsalya Scheme.

The Ministry conducted "Zonal and Sub-Zonal Meet Outreach Programme on 8 Years Achievement" with States/UTs on 02.04.2022 (Chandigarh), 04.04.2022 (Bengaluru), 09.04.2022 (Guwahati), 12.04.2022 (Mumbai), 13.04.2022 (Bhubaneshwar) and 04.07.2022 (Hyderabad). The Ministry also conducted "National Dissemination Workshop on Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and the rules thereunder and the Adoption Regulations, 2017" including implementation of Mission Vatsalya Scheme on 17.08.2022 and 29.08.2022 with all States/UTs, line Ministries and other stakeholders. Regional Symposium on "Child Protection, Child Safety and Child Welfare" have also been organised in Delhi on 02.07.2023 and in Bhopal on 09.07.2023.

The Mission Vatsalya scheme provides strategy for convergence for ensuring efficient and effective delivery of services through schemes and programmes of line Ministries/ Departments in order to realize desired outcomes of child welfare, safety and protection. The Ministry regularly follows up with the State/ UT Governments and various advisories have been sent so as to ensure the effective implementation of Mission Vatsalya Scheme.

- (b): State/UT-wise number of children registered under Institutional Care and Non-Institutional Care of the Mission Vatsalya Scheme is at Annexure-I.
- (c): Mission Vatsalya Scheme has no provision of breastfeeding counselling centres.
