**KOLAR GOLD FIELDS AS VENUE FOR G20**

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state :-

(a) the number of G20 meetings/summits planned in near future along with the venues decided/proposed for the same; and

(b) whether the Government has any proposal to consider the Bharat Gold Mines Ltd. premises at Kolar Gold Fields as one of the venues for the meeting of G20 Summit and if so, the details thereof?

(a) During India's ongoing G20 Presidency, around 200 meetings in over 50 locations are being held across the country in all States and Union Territories, in consultation with respective State and UT governments and administrations, including on functional and logistical aspects. These meetings comprise of official G20 Sherpa Track and Finance Track meetings, as well as Engagement Groups and Initiatives. The G20 Leaders Summit will be held in New Delhi on 09-10 September 2023.

(b) Presently, the venues of the official G20 meetings do not include the premises of Bharat Gold Mines Ltd. at Kolar Gold Fields.
