- (a) the details of the National Waterways on which freight transportation is operational;
- (b) whether the Government provides any financial incentives and benefits to encourage use of waterways as a medium of freight transportation;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to develop four national waterways in the States of Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Odisha along with the funds released/utilized therefor;
- (e) whether the freight transportation activities are operational on any of the four national waterways in the said States; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) The details of the National Waterways on which freight transportation is operational is given in **Annexure-1**

- (b) & (c) Yes, Sir. Ministry of Port Shipping and Waterways waived off the waterway usage charges at a rate of Rs 0.02 per gross registered tonnage (GRT) per kilometer for plying of Inland cargo vessels and Rs. 0.05 per gross registered tonnage (GRT) per kilometer for plying of Cruise vessels on national waterways to promote inland waterways as a supplementary, eco-friendly and cheaper mode of transport.
- (d) The details of National Waterways (NWs) declared in the States of Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, Rajasthan and Odisha under National Waterways Act, 2016 are at **Annexure-2**. Feasibility Studies/Detailed Project Reports have been completed of these NWs. As per the findings of the Feasibility Study/ Detailed Project Report, 2 NWs of Uttar Pradesh & 1 NW of Odisha have been taken up for development and funds utilized is detailed at **Annexure-3**. No NW was declared in the State of Madhya Pradesh in view of recommendation of the State Government
- (e) Freight transportation is taking place on National Waterway-1 {NW-1:Ganga-Bhagirathi-Hooghly River System (Haldia-Allahabad) in the State of Uttar Pradesh}, NW-73 (Narmada River) and NW-100 (Tapi River) in Gujarat, NW-64 (Mahanadi River), NW-5 (East Coast Canal And Matai River/Brahmani-Kharsua-Dhamra Rivers/Mahanadi Delta Rivers), NW-14 (Baitarni River) and NW-23 (Budha Balanga) in Odisha.
- (f) Freight transportation is not taking place in any National Waterway in the states of Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh as NWs of Rajasthan do not have adequate water for shipping & navigation as per studies completed. No NW was declared in the State of Madhya Pradesh in view of recommendation of State Government.
