Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government is aware about ambitious scheme Savitribai Phule Kishori Samridhi Yojana of Jharkhand Government providing Rs.40,000/to each girl from 8th to 12th class coming from economically weaker section and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Union Government proposes to implement any such scheme across the country; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) Govt. of Jharkhand has started Savitribai Phule Kishori Samridhi Yojana vide Department's Resolution No.2033, dated 05.09.2022 with the aim to reduce girls school dropouts in higher classes, for their education and empowerment. The Scheme is implemented in Schools operated by Government / Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes, Minorities and Backward Classes Welfare Department, Women, Child Development and Social Security Department, Jharkhand and for girls studying in Schools running under National Child Labour Project (NCLP).

As per eligibility conditions given by the State Government of Jharkhand, Mother/Father should not be income tax payer. Benefits are payable to the first two daughters of the mother and provision for relaxation is available in the above conditions in the case of disabled girls.

- (b) & (c) The Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India is implementing the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG). Under the Scheme, Adolescent Girls (AGs) in the age group of 14-18 years are covered in Aspirational Districts; and all districts of North Eastern States. Under the Scheme, services are provided under following Components:
- (i) **Nutrition:** There is a provision of providing supplementary nutrition containing 600 calories, 18-20 grams of protein and micronutrients to adolescent girls in the age group of 14-18 years for 300 days in a year.
- (ii) **Non Nutrition Component:** There is a provision for providing IFA supplementation, Health check-up and Referral services, Nutrition & Health Education and Skill Training
