- (a) whether the Government has set up National Chemicals and Fertilizers Limited Plant in Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps to open such Fertilizer plants in other districts including Alwar in Rajasthan;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government has sanctioned a fertilizer project of Rashtriya Chemicals and Fertilizers Limited in Rajasthan; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b): Government has not set up any National Chemicals and Fertilizers Limited Plant in Rajasthan.
- (c) & (d): Government had notified New Investment Policy (NIP) 2012 on 02nd January, 2013 and its amendment on 7th October 2014 to facilitate fresh investment in urea sector and to make India self-sufficient in the urea sector. Total six new urea units have been set up under NIP-2012 across the country including the Gadepan-III urea unit of Chambal Fertilizers and Chemicals Ltd. (CFCL) which is located at Gadepan in Kota district of Rajasthan State. The installed urea production capacity of the unit is 12.7 Lakh Metric Tonne per annum.
- (e) & (f): Government has not sanctioned any fertilizer project of Rashtriya Chemicals and Fertilizers Limited in Rajasthan.
