Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the details of various centrally sponsored schemes being implemented by the Ministry in the country, including Assam and particularly Kokrajhar;

(b) the details of the funds allocated by the Government in this regard, State/UT-wise since 2019 to till date and year-wise;

(c) whether the Government has taken many initiatives to improve the health infrastructure in North-East, particularly in Assam;

(d) the details of the steps taken by the Government for Advanced Medical Sciences in Assam; and

(e) whether it is a fact that the Government have decided to set up National Centre for Disease Control in Assam and if so, the details thereof along with the present status of the project?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. S. P. SINGH BAGHEL)

(a) to (d) The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare through various Centrally Sponsored Schemes and Central Sector Schemes supplements the efforts of the States / UTs in the healthcare sector. The details of some of the major schemes / projects which are implemented in the country including North East and particularly Kokrajhar district of Assam along with the details of expenditure / funds released since the financial year 2019-20 is attached at Annexure. The medical infrastructure has been strengthened for advanced medical services in Assam through various schemes.

(e) The Government has decided to set up Regional NCDC (National Centre for Disease Control) in Assam to cater to all the States of the North Eastern Region for which the land has been identified in Rani CHC, Guwahati, Assam.
