Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is formulating any scheme for health programmes under the Centres for Disease Control in Rajasthan;
- (b) whether the Government has formulated any mechanism to review the programmes under National Centres for Disease Control and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the outcome of the latest review to ascertain the efficacy of these projects?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. SATYA PAL SINGH BAGHEL)

(a) to (c):

National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC) under Ministry of Health & Family Welfare supports States/UTs in management of communicable and infectious prone diseases. It works towards strengthening the disease surveillance system, outbreak investigations and provide required technical support to States/UTs in managing any health emergency. NCDC also provide technical guidance & support to states in terms of implementation of national action plan on containment of Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR), surveillance of Viral Hepatitis, One Health approach for prevention and control of zoonoses, Rabies control, prevention and control of Leptospirosis and issues related to Climate Change & Health. All these activities are coordinated across all States/UTs including Rajasthan.

Besides monitoring through the Output-Outcome Monitoring Framework by NITI Aayog, all programmes are monitored through regular reviews at senior level in the Ministry.
