DISPLACEMENT OF MEDICAL STUDENTS

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that many tribal students of medical and nursing colleges in Imphal valley have been displaced due to ongoing ethnic crisis in Manipur;
- (b) if so, whether the Government maintains the data of such displaced students and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has any plan to relocate these tribal students in other medical education institutions in neighbouring States of Manipur as they could not return to the Imphal valley due to fear of losing their lives; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?
