ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) & (b) The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has taken up the task to formulate a National Menstrual Hygiene Policy. A National consultation with various stakeholders has been held and in- person inputs have been collated. The policy covers all women, girls and all persons who menstruate in our country.
