(a) & (b) The pre-draft version of the National Curriculum Framework for School Education developed under the guidance of National Steering Committee, was released in April, 2023.

(c) to (f) The pre-draft was made public for the feedback of all the stakeholders. Based on the feedback, different modalities and approaches were critically examined and relevant changes were incorporated. Some of these changes include-

- I. Restructuring the document.
- II. Editing sections (e.g., parts of the social science chapter)
- III. Addition of a section on a course on Indian Knowledge Systems.
- IV. Changes in curricular design and approach to Board assessment in the secondary stage.
