Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a number of historically significant forts across the country, especially in Tamil Nadu, are in dilapidated condition;
- (b) if so, the details of works undertaken by Government for the maintenance and preservation of the forts, State-wise;
- (c) the details of the persons/agencies appointed for this work;
- (d) whether these persons/agencies have knowledge/experience of maintenance/preservation of the forts; and
- (e) the details of total amount spent by Government for the maintenance of forts during the last three years, year-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF CULTURE, TOURISM AND DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION (SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

- (a) Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has 14 forts under its jurisdiction in the State of
- & Tamil Nadu. There is no fort in dilapidated condition under the jurisdiction of ASI in the
- (b) country including Tamil Nadu. The conservation and preservation of these forts are taken up as per the requirement and availability of resources and they are in good state of preservation.
- (c) ASI follows its guidelines for the conservation of protected monuments/sites including
- & forts as per the National Conservation Policy, 2014. Conservation works are carried out
- (d) by in house staff of ASI.
- (e) The details of expenditure incurred for the maintenance of 14 forts in the State of Tamil Nadu during the last three years are given as under:-
