Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) the number of expectant women availing the benefits of central health schemes in Primary Health Centres across different parts of the country, particularly in Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu and Maharashtra along with State/UT-wise details thereof;

(b) the number of infants vaccinated every year under Central Health Schemes, State/UT-wise;

(c) the details of the procedure adopted by the Government to monitor the implementation of these schemes; and

(d) the number of rural women likely to be registered under Central Health Schemes in the coming years, State/UT-wise including Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu and Maharashtra?

#### ANSWER

# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a): The number of expectant women benefited under Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan (PMSMA) in Primary Health Centres, state/UT-wise including Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu and Maharashtra is at **Annexure-I**.

(b): Number of infants fully vaccinated in 2022-23 under Universal Immunization Programme State/UT-wise as per Health Management Information System (HMIS) is at **Annexure-II**.

- (c): Procedures adopted by the Government to monitor the implementation of these schemes:
- 1. Centralised PMSMA Portal: A centralised PMSMA portal has been created, All PMSMA facilities are regularly entering monthly service static reports in the PMSMA Portal. According to the report, the scheme's progress is monitored on monthly, quarterly, and annual basis at National level and shared the suggestions and feedback for further improvement to all states and UTs.
- 2. Concurrent monitoring and supportive supervision by field monitors and National Public Health Support Network to identify the status of immunization coverage.
- 3. Real time monitoring of antigen wise coverage by Health Management Information System Network and by periodic survey such as National Family Health Surveys (NFHS)
- 4. Field visits by National monitors to review the implementation of the programme.
- 5. Surveillance monitoring of Vaccine preventable diseases such as Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Measles, Rubella and Polio to identify outbreaks due to gaps in the immunization coverage.

(d): The Central Health Schemes launched under NHM are accessible by all category of people including rural women. Anyone can avail these services free of cost as per their choice.
