VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRES

2911: SHRI JAGDAMBIKA PAL: SHRIMATI RAJASHREE MALLICK:

Will the Minister of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship be pleased to state:

(a) the numbers of Vocational Training Centres functioning under the Government, Statewise and district-wise data including Uttar Pradesh and Jagatsinghpur district of Odisha;

(b) whether more such centres are required to be opened to fulfill the current demand in the country;

(c) whether the Government provides any scholarship to student to enroll themselves in vocational education and if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether any assessment has been made for the new skill trainings that can be imparted and if so, the details thereof along with the placement records so far?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

(a) The Skill India Mission (SIM) of the Govt. of India is aimed at Skilling, Re-skilling and Upskilling to ensure our youth are prepared for the large number of opportunities coming up as the economy expands and India moves from the 10th largest economy to 3rd largest economy in the world. SIM is aimed at future ready and Industry ready talent among youths.

Under the SIM, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill training through an extensive network of skill development centers / institutes under its various schemes .The Craftsman Training is provided through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), The Craft Instructor Training is provided through National Skill Training Institutes (NSTIs) and Institute of Training of Trainers (IToTs), In addition, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), and Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS) also provide skill training to trainees across the country.

State/UTs wise list of ITIs, NSTIs & ITOTs, JSS, and PMKVY centers are attached at *Annexure-1, Annexure-2, Annexure-3,* and *Annexure-4 respectively*.

District wise list of number of ITIs, NSTIS & ITOTs, JSS, and PMKVY centers in Uttar Pradesh State are attached at *Annexure-5, Annexure-6, Annexure-7,* and *Annexure-8 respectively*.

District wise list of number of ITIs, NSTIS & ITOTs, JSS, and PMKVY centers in Odisha State are attached at *Annexure-9, Annexure-10, Annexure-11,* and *Annexure-12 respectively.*

(b) The establishment and administration of ITIs comes under the jurisdiction of State Government, while the policies formulation such as setting the criterion for affiliation, conducting the examination along with certification, and designing curriculum are the responsibilities of the Central Government. New ITIs are set up as and when proposals are received from the State governments. These proposals are examined as per the prescribed affiliation criteria and affiliation granted.

The PMKVY scheme is a demand-driven scheme and as per the industry and local demand, training is provided in training centers.

(c) Scholarship is not provided by MSDE to the trainees enrolled in Vocational Training Centers. However, under PMKVY for the Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed component, successfully certified candidates are paid reward Money of INR 500 through DBT.

(d) In the area of long-term training, under Directorate General of Training (DGT), the New Age Course are designed and delivered nationwide through the network of ITIs. The objective of New Age Course is to provide new age skills to cater to the needs of new-age industries. Some of the new courses are Smart Agriculture (Internet of Things), Smart Healthcare (Internet of Things), Smart City (Internet of Things), Drone Technician, Solar Technician (Electrical), etc. There is no centralized data base about the employment of candidates after completing their course.

However, as per report of a tracer study of ITI pass outs, conducted by the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship through an Independent Agency and published in 2018, about 63.5 % of ITI Graduates are employed out of which 6.7 % are self-employed. Under PMKVY, since inception, 138.31 lakh trainees have been trained/oriented out of which, 24.37 lakh have been reported placed.
