## **GROWTH OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT IN WEST BENGAL**

2936. SHRI SUNIL KUMAR MONDAL:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the works done for the growth of skill development in West Bengal for the last three years and the current year with new schemes;

(b) the number of people connected with such schemes in West Bengal; and

(c) the details of the funds allocated and utilised during the Financial Year 2022-23, State/UT-wise along with the present and upcoming schemes?

#### ANSWER

(a) The Skill India Mission (SIM) of the Govt of India is aimed at Skilling, Re-skilling and Upskilling to ensure our youth are prepared for the large number of opportunities coming up as the economy expands and India moves from the 10<sup>th</sup> largest economy to 3<sup>rd</sup> largest economy in the world. SIM is aimed at future ready and Industry ready talent among the youths.

Under SIM, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, Reskill and Up-skill training through various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to all the sections of the society across the country including in the State of West Bengal.

(b) The total number of candidates trained in the State of West Bengal during 2020-21 to 30.06.2023 in the aforementioned schemes is as under:

(c) State-wise Grants-in-Aid released under PMKVY during 2022-23 is at Annexure-I. Under JSS, grants-in-aid are being released to Non-Government Organisations (NGOs) directly. The Grants-in-Aid released to these NGOs, State-wise is given at Annexure-II.

Day-to-day administration as well as financial control in respect of ITIs lies with the respective State Governments/Union Territory Administration. Under NAPS, establishments are incentivised by way of stipend support.
