SURVEY TO IDENTIFY HERITAGE SITES

Will the **Minister of CULTURE** be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government has conducted any survey to identify the heritage sites in the country and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of the heritage sites where development work has been started during the last three years and the current year;
- (c) the details of the development work carried out so far, heritage site-wise; and
- (d) the details of these heritage sites located in Jharkhand where holistic development work has been started or proposed to be undertaken?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF CULTURE, TOURISM AND DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

- (a) Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) regularly conducts Village to Village Survey to explore and record the antiquarian remains. The details are at Annexure-I.
- (b) On annual basis ASI undertakes special nature of conservation, preservation and environmental
- & development of about 600-700 monuments out of 3696 monuments/sites across the country.
- (c) Remaining are taken up for annual maintenance. Further, amenities like drinking water & toilets and facilitates like pathways, ramps, visitor benches, signages, wheel chairs, dustbins, light & sound show, publication sale counters, etc. are provided. Conservation and providing facilities at monuments is a regular phenomenon.
- (d) The monument and sites taken up for maintenance and development in the State of Jharkhand are
 - i. Ancient Shiva Temple, Khekparta, District Lohardaga
 - ii. Ancient tank and remains of temples and structures at Benisagar, District W. Singhbhum
 - iii. Jami Mosque, Hadaf, District Sahibgani
 - iv. Baradari of Mouza, Arzimukhimpur, District Sahibganj
 - v. Palace and temple complex, Navaratanagarh, District Gumla
 - vi. Temples at Haradih, District Ranchi
 - vii. Terracotta temple (Dhobi Math), Navaratanagarh, Sisai, District Gumla (Unprotected)
 - viii. Baoli Math, Navaratanagarh, Sisai, District Gumla (Unprotected)
