(a) whether any national fund has been allocated to Delhi with a view to protect the capital city from floods and provide other facilities including sanitation and safety;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the details of the guidelines issued by the Union Government to the State Government and the action taken on it during the last three years and till now?

(a) and (b) The Delhi Disaster Response Fund (DDRF) has been constituted by the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (GNCTD) as per section 48(1)(a) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, in which 80% contribution is provided by the Government of India as Grant-in-aid for providing immediate relief to the victims of cyclone, drought, earthquake, fire, flood, tsunami, hailstorm, landslide, avalanche, cloud burst, pest attack and cold wave/frost.

(c) This Ministry vide O.M. No.33-03/2021-NDM-I dated 12.01.2022 has issued Guidelines on the Constitution and Administration of State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF), which are implemented by the respective State Governments.
