FUNDS ALLOCATED TO UT OF LADAKH

### 3012. SHRI JAMYANG TSERING NAMGYAL:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the funds received by Union Territory (UT) of Ladakh from Union Government as Grant of Demands and the funds spent thereafter grant of UT status, sector-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has proposed any plans to spend the funds on priority basis in UT of Ladakh; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

### ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

- (a): The sector-wise details of the funds received by the Union Territory

  (UT) of Ladakh from the Union Government as Demand for Grants and the

  funds spent after grant of status of the UT, are given in Annexure.
- (b) & (c): The Government is making all endeavors to spend funds on priority. For optimum utilization of funds, the Government has taken a number of steps such as authorization of Annual Action Plan in the month of April every financial year, release of funds to the line departments in the beginning of the financial year, instructions to the departments of the UT

of Ladakh to prepare plan for all construction works in advance, delegation of financial powers to officers in remote areas, introduction of Ladakh Integrated Financial Management System (LIFMS), capacity building of employees in Government e-Marketplace (GEM), Public Financial Management System (PFMS), e-Tenders, e-Office, Project Management, etc.

As a result of Government's endeavors, the utilization of funds has improved substantially in the financial year 2022-23 as compared to the financial year 2021-22 and financial year 2020-21. Expenditure of  $\stackrel{?}{=}$  4,179.66 crores (70.15%) was incurred in the financial year 2022-23 out of the allocation of BE of  $\stackrel{?}{=}$  5,958 crores as compared to an expenditure of  $\stackrel{?}{=}$  3,795.78 crores (63.71%) in the financial year 2021-22 and  $\stackrel{?}{=}$  2,374.00 crores (39.84%) in the financial year 2020-21.
