- (a) the details on the budget allocated and the number of training institutes set up under the Rural Self Employment Training Institute (RSETI) Scheme, State-wise particularly in the States of Rajasthan, Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh and Odisha;**
- (b) whether the Ministry provides any financial assistance to the rural youth for starting their enterprise after the training courses are completed and if so, details thereof; and**
- (c) the data on the settlement rate of RSETItrained candidates till June 2023, State and district-wise particularly Pali Parliamentary Constituency of Rajasthan, Pratapgarh, Deoria and Jhansi Parliamentary Constituencies of Uttar Pradesh and Balasore Parliamentary Constituency of Odisha?**

- (a) Under the Rural Self Employment Training Institute (RSETI) scheme, currently 590 RSETIs are functioning in 572 districts across 33 States/UTs led by banks and funded by Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD). It is a demand driven programme hence state-wise allocations are not being made. However, State-wise details of funds released during 2022-23 is given at Annexure-I. The State-wise**

details of RSETIs set up (including the states of Rajasthan, Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh and Odisha) are given at Annexure-II.

(b) RSETIs are extending assistance for credit linkage through sponsor banks and other bank/financial institutions to the trained candidates requiring credit for settlement. The details of candidates provided assistance with respect to credit linkage in 2022-23 are provided at Annexure-III.

(c) The State-wise details of the candidates trained and settled for 2022-23 and 2023-24 (as on June 30, 2023) are given at Annexure-IV along with training and settlement figures for Pali, Pratapgarh, Deoria, Jhansi and Balasore Districts.
