PMMSY in Odisha

3021. SHRI BASANTA KUMAR PANDA:

Will the Minister of **FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING** **मत्स्य पालन, पशु पालन और डेयरी मंत्री** be pleased to state:

- the number of beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) in Odisha, district-wise during the last four years;
- the fish production before 2020 and after 2020 in tonnes in the district of Kalahandi and Nuapada including the State of Odisha along with the percentage increase; and
- the fish export earnings under the said yojana after 2020 along with percentage increase in export earnings?

(a) & (b): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has been implementing “Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY)” with highest ever estimated investment of Rs. 20050 crore in fisheries sector for a period of 5 years with effect from the financial year 2020-21. As reported by Government of Odisha, the number of beneficiaries benefitted under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) in Odisha, district-wise during the last three years furnished at Annexure-I.

Fish production in Odisha before 2020 and after 2020 including Kalahandi and Nuapada district of Odisha as reported by Government of Odisha furnished below:
