- (a) whether it is a fact that the Government is considering to give free Doordarshan Direct-To-Home (DTH) connections and facilitate better mobile connectivity in the far flung villages along the Indo-China border;

- (c) the steps taken by the Government to distribute over 1.5 lakh free dish connections in the said villages?
