REPAIR AND UPGRADATION OF ROADS UNDER PMGSY-III

3045. SHRI SUBHASH CHANDRA BAHERIA:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of budget provisions made for reconstruction and repair of roads under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for Bhilwara Parliamentary Constituency during each of the last four years and the current year;**
- (b) the number of roads upgraded and repaired under PMGSY-III in the above Constituency during the said period;**
- (c) the details of funds allocated and released by the Government for the above purpose for the said Constituency; and**
- (d) the target length of roads likely to be completed in the above Constituency till 2024?**

ANSWER

(a) 'Rural road' is a State subject. As per the programme guidelines of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), reconstruction and maintenance of roads constructed under the programme is the responsibility of the State Governments. As PMGSY is a one-time assistance programme for construction of rural roads, there is no provision under it for re-construction and repair of roads. Central funds are released to the State Government for construction and upgradation of roads which are sanctioned under various interventions of PMGSY.

(b) to (d) The funds for implementation of PMGSY are released to the States/ UTs on the basis of the proposals received from them and also

depend on works in hand, execution capacity and unspent funds. Further release of funds to the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) is done by the State Governments depending upon the absorption capacity of the PIUs.

Parliamentary Constituency wise details for PMGSY are not maintained in the Ministry. A total of 30 road works of total 253.95 km length have been sanctioned under PMGSY-III for Bhilwara district, out of which 20 road work of 169.27 km road length has been completed and an expenditure of Rs. 70.95 crore has been incurred.

The implementation period of PMGSY-III is up to March 2025.
