# LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 3079 ANSWERED ON 08/08/2023

#### SPECIAL EDUCATION UNDER DDUGKY

3079. SHRI MOHANBHAI KALYANJI KUNDARIYA: SHRI DINESH LAL YADAV "NIRAHUA": SHRI DIPSINH SHANKARSINH RATHOD: SHRI GOPAL JEE THAKUR:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of training that is being provided to youths under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), State and districtwise particularly in Gujarat and Darbhanga district of Bihar;
- (b) whether any special educational/training curriculum has been prepared for them in this regard;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether youths who are undergoing this training are being provided stipend/scholarship/financial assistance during the training period; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof, State and districtwise particularly in Gujarat and Darbhanga district of Bihar?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- (a): The training being imparted to the youths under DDU-GKY across the country, including in Gujarat and Bihar, is based on the Qualification Packs approved by the National Skills Qualification Committee. The training consists of theory, practical and on-the-job training (OJT) imparted in domain skills, computer skills, soft skills and English.
- (b) & (c): No special educational/ training curriculum has been prepared under DDU-GKY.

- (d): No stipend/ scholarship is being provided to either residential or non-residential candidates during the training period. Many of the assistance/ benefits given to residential and non-residential candidates during the training period are non-financial in nature. However, the following two benefits provided during the training period qualify as financial assistance, either partially or fully;
  - i. 'One-time travel cost' for residential trainees (partially)
- ii. 'Food and transport cost' for non-residential trainees (fully)

The details of such assistance during the training period, according to the Guidelines of DDU-GKY, are given below;
