**FAILURE OF STATES TO IMPLEMENT PMAY-G**

**3080. SHRI M. BADRUDDIN AJMAL:**

**Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the number of beneficiaries who got the amount for houses construction under the centrally sponsored flagship scheme namely Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) during each of the last five years, State-wise and district-wise;**
- (b) whether it is true that some States constantly fail to implement the said yojana and if so, the details of such States; and**
- (c) the details of funds allocated and its utilization report under the yojana during the said period?**

**(a) to (c): In order to achieve the target of “Housing for All” in rural areas, the Ministry of Rural Development is implementing PradhanMantriAwaasYojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2016 to provide assistance to eligible rural households with an overall target to construct 2.95 crore pucca houses with basic amenities by March, 2024. Against the mandated target of 2.95 crore houses, a total of. 2.93 crore houses have already been sanctioned to the beneficiaries by various States/UTs and construction of 2.41 crore houses has also been completed as on**

**02.08.2023. The scheme has been able to achieve its major milestones and the Ministry is committed to achieving the target of construction of 2.95 crore pucca houses by the deadline prescribed of 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024.**

**The Year-wise and State/UT-wise details of houses sanctioned to eligible beneficiaries under PradhanMantriAwaasYojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) during each of the last five years i.e., from the financial year 2018-19 to 2022-23 is given in Annexure. The District level data of all States/UTs related to houses allocated and completed can be seen at programme website at [www.pmayg.nic.in](http://www.pmayg.nic.in)--->AwaasSoft--->Reports--->Houses progress against the target financial year.**

**The Central Assistance under PMAY-G is released directly to the State/UT considering the State/UT as a unit. Further release of these funds to beneficiaries in various Districts/Blocks/GPs is done by the respective State Government/UT Administration.**

**The amount of Central Share of funds released to the States/UTs for construction of houses under PMAY-G during the last five years i.e., from the financial year 2018-19 to 2022-23 was around Rs.1,60,853.38 crore. The corresponding utilization of funds by the States/UTs was Rs.2,39,055.11 crore including State/UT Share.**
