#### ECONOMIC STABILITY OF TRANSGENDERS

#### 3088. SHRI RAJENDRA AGRAWAL:

### Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of transgenders in the country, State-wise;
- (b) whether the State of Uttar Pradesh has the highest absolute number of Transgenders in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there is any Garima Greh in Uttar Pradesh, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) whether the Government has taken any steps for the inclusion and economic stability of Transgender persons in Uttar Pradesh, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons there for?

# ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SHRI A. NARAYANASWAMY)

- (a): The Registrar General of India (RGI), during Enumeration of Census 2011, provided three codes i.e. Male-1, Female-2 and other-3 for enumeration. Thus, the category of 'other' would not only include 'transgender' but also any person who desires to record sex under the category of 'other'. The population of 'other' as per Census 2011 is 4,87,803. The State/UT wise list of 'other' is annexed.
- (b): As per Census 2011, 137465 persons have opted for "other" option in sex column in State of Uttar Pradesh which is the highest.
- (c) and (d): There is no Garima Greh operating in the State of Uttar Pradesh as of now. However, one Transgender Welfare Board has been setup in State of Uttar Pradesh. The Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) 2019 has been enacted by Government which provides for all necessary measures by appropriate Government for the welfare of Transgender persons and mainstreaming them into the society.
