- (a) The Neighbourhood Youth Parliament is a component of the scheme National Young Leaders Programme. The programme aims at developing leadership qualities among youth to enable them to realize their full potential and in the process, to contribute to the nation-building process. It also aims to motivate the youth to strive for excellence in their respective fields and to bring them to the forefront of the development process. It seeks to harness the immense youth energy by actively involving them in the governance process by providing them a platform to articulate their views at Block and District level program on various socio-economic development issues of concern to them.
- (b) The Neighbourhood Youth Parliament Programmes were organised at Block Level during 2020-21. During 2021-22 & 2022-23the programmes were held at District Level. The state wise number of programs organized is placed at Annexure-I.

(c) Details of quantum of funds spent in organizing the Neighbourhood youth parliament from 2020-21 to 2022-23 is placed at Annexure-II. The program has provided effective platform to the Youth to deliberate and voice opinions on various socio-economic development issues of concern through their participation in the program at Block and District level.
