## (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a) and (b): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying is implementing a flagship scheme namely Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) with an investment of ₹20050 crore in all the States and Union Territories (UTs) for a period of 5 years with effect from the financial year 2020-21 to FY 2024-25 for holistic development of the fisheries sector in the country. During the last three financial years (FY 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23), and current financial year (2023-24) projects worth of Rs. 15822.54 crore with a central share of Rs. 6546.57 crore have been approved and central funds of Rs. 3051.23 crore has been released to various State Governments/Union Territories and other implementing agencies under PMMSY for development of fisheries sector in the country. The Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana being implemented *inter-alia* envisages enhancing the productivity from 3 tonnes/hectare to 5 tonnes/hectare in the country by 2024-25.
