#### **FAMILIES COVERED UNDER DAY-NRLM**

#### 3152. SHRI JANARDAN SINGH SIGRIWAL:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of families which have been covered under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM) during each of the last three years, State/UT-wise including Bihar;
- (b) whether there are still many families in different rural areas of the country who have been deprived from the benefits of this mission:
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the corrective measures taken by the Government in this regard?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- a): The State/UT-wise details of the rural households mobilised into Self Help Groups (SHGs) under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) during the last three year, including in Bihar, is placed at Annexure I.
- b) and c): DAY-NRLM Mission has already mobilized approximately 9.36 crore women from rural households into 86.18 lakh SHGs as on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2023 and the work is ongoing.

d): The Ministry organiseda social mobilization campaign from 7<sup>th</sup> September to 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2022. This year, "Sangathan Se SamriddhiAbhiyaan" has been launched from April 18<sup>th</sup> till 15th August 2023 in order to expedite the process of social mobilization for bringing women from left out eligible rural poor households into Self Help Groups (SHGs) under the DAY-NRLM. During the period of "Sangathan Se SamriddhiAbhiyaan", upto 31st July 2023, 37,10,386 households have been mobilised into 2,81,479 SHGs.
