PM-AASHA SCHEME

3165. SHRI RAVIKUMAR D :

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the manner in which deficiency payments are undertaken under the Pradhan Mantri Annadata Aay Sanrakshhan Abhiyan (PM-AASHA);
- (b) the number of States and UTs which have opted for the same;
- (c) whether there is evidence that the farmers are receiving an increased Minimum Support Price (MSP) under the Abhiyan;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the details of the contribution of the Abhiyan in providing MSP for cash crops?

ANSWER

कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR)

(a) to (e) : PM-AASHA, an umbrella scheme comprising Price Support Scheme (PSS), Price Deficiency Payment Scheme (PDPS) and Private Procurement & Stockist Scheme (PPSS) is implemented in order to ensure Minimum Support Price (MSP) to farmers for their produce of notified oilseeds, pulses and copra. These schemes are implemented at the request of the State Governments / Union Territories. PSS is implemented for procurement of notified pulses, oilseeds and copra of Fair Average Quality (FAQ) at Minimum Support Price (MSP), whereas PDPS is implemented for notified oilseeds. However, States/UTs have options to choose either PSS or PDPS in a given procurement season with respect to a particular oilseed crop for the entire State. PDPS envisages direct payment of the difference between the MSP and the selling / modal price to pre- registered farmers selling oilseeds of prescribed Fair Average Quality (FAQ) norms within the stipulated period in the notified market yard through a transparent auction process. All the payments are done directly into the bank account of farmers. This scheme does not involve any physical procurement. States/UTs have also an option to implement PPSS for oilseeds in district/selected APMC(s) of district involving the participation of private stockist. During Kharif 2018-19 season, Government of Madhya Pradesh had opted PDPS for Soyabean crop.

Statement of state-wise procurement details of pulses, oilseeds & copra procured at MSP under PSS from 2020-21 to 2022-23 along with farmers benefited is at Annexure.
