(a) & (b):- In order to ensure overall growth and development of Food Processing Industries, Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) has been incentivizing setting up/expansion of related infrastructure through its Central Sector Umbrella Scheme Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY), Production Linked Incentive Scheme for Food Processing Industry (PLISFPI) and Centrally sponsored PM Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) scheme across the country. PMKSY is not any region or state specific but demand driven and is implemented across the country. The details of the projects approved under component schemes of PMKSY across the Country during the last five years is placed at **Annexure-I**. The details of projects approved for assistance and funds released to the States/UTs under PMFME Scheme, since inception of the scheme i.e. 2020-21, is placed at **Annexure-II**.

ANNEXURE REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (c) OF THE LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 3210 ANSWERED ON 08.08.2023 REGARDING DEVELOPMENT OF FOOD PROCESSING SECTOR

The Assistance available under component schemes of PMKSY

Under component schemes of PMKSY, MoFPI mostly provides financial assistance in the form of grants-in-aid to entrepreneurs for creation of modern infrastructure and setting up of food processing / preservation industries. Grants-in-aid @ 35 % of eligible project cost, subject to maximum prescribed limit, is provided for general areas for setting up of Food Processing Industries under component schemes of PMKSY, as per current scheme guidelines. Special incentive is admissible for projects approved for SC/ST entrepreneurs / North eastern Region and other difficult and hilly areas.

The details of assistance available to Micro Food Processing Enterprises under PMFME Scheme

(i). *Support to Individual / Group Category Micro Enterprises:* Credit-linked capital subsidy @35% of the eligible project cost, maximum ceiling Rs.10 lakh per unit;

(ii). *Support to SHGs for seed capital:* Seed capital @ Rs. 40,000/- per member of SHG engaged in food processing for working capital and purchase of small tools subject to maximum of Rs. 4 lakh per SHG Federation.

(iii). *Support for Common Infrastructure:* Credit linked capital subsidy @35% subject to maximum of Rs. 3 crore to support FPOs, SHGs, Cooperatives and any Government agency for setting up of common infrastructure. The common infrastructure will also be available for other units and public to utilize on hiring basis for substantial part of the capacity.

(iv). *Branding and Marketing Support:* Grant upto 50% for Branding and Marketing to groups of FPOs/ SHGs/ Cooperatives or an SPV of micro food processing enterprises.

(v) . *Capacity Building:* The scheme envisages training for Entrepreneurship Development Skilling to meet the requirement of food processing industry and product specific skilling.
