#### **ALLOCATION OF BUDGET FOR SPMRM**

#### **3219. SHRI KALYAN BANERJEE:**

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that there is no allocation in budget 2023-24 for the Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Rurban Mission (SPMRM);
- (b) whether it is also a fact that the objective of SPMRM is to stimulate local economic development, enhance basic services and create well planned Rurban clusters thereunder;
- (c) if so, with an overall reduction of over 12 percent in 2023-24 budget against revised estimates of 2022-23 with no allocation for SPMRM, the plan details of the Government towards such development; and
- (d) the details and present status of Rurban projects, State-wise?

#### ANSWER

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- (a): There is no budgetary allocation for Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) for the Financial Year 2023-24, as the scheme has come to an end with its sunset date being 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022.
- (b): Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) was launched as an attempt to make the selected rural areas socially, economically and physically sustainable regions by providing economic, social, basic and digital amenities, thus leading to sustainable and balanced regional development in the country. The objective of the Mission is to stimulate local economic development, enhance basic services, and create well planned Rurban clusters.

- (c): The scheme was launched on 21st February 2016. 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022 has been announced as the sunset date for the scheme. A one-time financial sanction was approved by the Government of India to release funds upto 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023. This one-time financial sanction was accorded for works that were already ongoing as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022.
- (d): As per the RurbanSoft MIS, 34351 works have been completed while 15872 works are ongoing in the various clusters across the country. The State-wise work progress is given at Annexure.
