Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether NITI Aayog has released the plan for monetisation of the assets of the Central Government and public enterprises under National Monetisation Pipeline (NMP);
- (b) the total amount collected from the private entities and the number of private entities availed under this scheme;
- (c) the total amount collected from the private entities from Tamil Nadu out of the above;
- (d) the details of the monetisation models and their utilization; and
- (e) whether the assets of State Government are included in the NMP and if so, the details thereof?

- (a) National Monetisation Pipeline (NMP) was launched in August 2021 to enable accelerated creation of infrastructure in the country.
- (b) During the years 2021-22 and 2022-23, transactions with aggregate monetisation value of about Rs. 97,000 crore and Rs 1.3 lakh crore respectively in terms of accruals or private investment were completed.

(c, d & e) Monetisation of assets identified under NMP is envisaged either through structured Public Private Partnership (PPP) framework or through capital market-based instruments. The detailed structure is normally finalised on a case-to-case basis in accordance with extant guidelines and regulations subject to appraisal and approval by competent authority.

State-wise monetization details are not being maintained under NMP with linear assets typically falling across a number of States. NMP only covers brownfield assets of identified statutory entities, public sector enterprises and other undertakings within the purview of ministries/ departments of Govt. of India.
