- (a) to (c): PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan (NMP), launched in October 2021, is a transformative approach for integrated infrastructure development for multi-modal, first and last mile connectivity to the economic nodes and social infrastructure. Planning on NMP brings Ease of Doing Business as well as Ease of Living for the citizens, by enabling seamless movement of people and goods. As on date, NMP has relevant GIS data layers pertaining to the available infrastructural assets which is being used for planning multimodal infrastructure. This includes both public and private industrial and other economic assets under the jurisdiction of various Ministries/ Departments of the Centre, States and UT. As of now, access to NMP is available only to authorized Central and State/UT Government personnel.
- (d): The list of 91 projects of various Central Ministries/Departments, evaluated by Network Planning Group (NPG) under PM Gati Shakti, as on date, is available on DPIIT's website under the following link-.
