- (c) the passenger capacity of the unreserved general coaches in India and the total number of passengers on an average who travelled in these unreserved coaches;
- (d) whether the Government is planning to deal with the issue of overcrowded unreserved general coaches, if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government has made any special general unreserved coaches for women;

- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (g) whether the Government is considering to introduce advanced types of unreserved coaches for better passenger experience, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (h) whether the Government is attaching coaches in long distance trains for the passengers travelling in unreserved class under Deen Dayalu Scheme; and
- (i) if so, the details of coaches attached for passengers travelling in unreserved class during each of the last three years?

(a) & (b) It is a continuous endeavour of Indian Railways (IR) to facilitate comfortable journey to all passengers. Non AC LHB coaches with better comfort and amenities are being manufactured.

At present, all reserved/unreserved coaches are equipped with all required amenities which include comfortable seat, toilets, wash basin, longitudinal luggage rakes, hook, fan, Mobile charging points etc.

(c) The normal per coach passenger capacity of unreserved LHB & ICF general coach is 100 and 90 respectively.

The total number of passengers carried in unreserved coaches during last two years is as below:

(d), (h) & (i) On IR, demand pattern of reserved accommodation is not uniform throughout the year and varies over lean and peak periods.

IR constantly monitors the wait list position of trains and demand. To deal with peak demand and rush in trains, IR endeavours to provide additional accomodation & enhance the carrying capacity by augmenting the trains both on temporary and permanent basis, extend

and increase the frequency of existing services, operate special train service & introduce new trains, subject to operational feasibility and availability of resources.

The total non AC coaches (General & Sleeper) are about two-third of total holding of coaches. The details are as under:
