- (a) whether the Government has taken or proposes to take necessary steps to ensure stoppage of trains running from Gwalior to Chhapra at Bilhaur railway station under Misrikh Parliamentary Constituency of Uttar Pradesh;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and**
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?**

(a) to (c) Bilhaur station, situated on the Kanpur-Farrukhabad section, is presently, being served by 8 pairs of train services, which are adequately catering to the needs of passengers of the station. However, 11123/24 running from Gwalior to Barauni via Chhapra does not pass through Bilhaur railway station.
