FOODGRAINS DAMAGED IN MONSOONS

- (d) whether the Government has come up with innovative and tech-based solutions to tackle damage to foodgrains in monsoons; and**
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

(a): Food Corporation of India (FCI) procures, stores & handles huge quantities of foodgrains. Procured foodgrains are stored in a scientific manner. In spite of all precautionary measures, a very negligible quantity of foodgrains accrue as damaged mainly due to natural calamities viz. flood, cyclone rain etc.

The details on the quantity of foodgrains, which got damaged due to monsoon factors *i.e.* flood, cyclone rain etc in godowns of FCI during the last five years are as under:

Year	Non-Issuable Foodgrains Accrued (In LMT)	Off-take Quantity (Excluding DCP) (Figures in LMT)	% of Damaged Foodgrains against Off-take Quantity (Excluding DCP)
2018-19	0.052	500.08	0.010
2019-20	0.019	455.13	0.004
2020-21	0.019	688.57	0.003
2021-22	0.017	766.08	0.002
2022-23	0.016	675.826	0.002

(b) and (c): Natural calamities like floods, rains and cyclones are the main reasons for damage of foodgrains.

(d) and (e): The foodgrains procured for central pool are stored in godowns/silos which are scientifically designed.
