(a) the details of foodgrains damaged during monsoons in the last five years;
(b) whether the Government has done any study or analysis to understand the reasons for damage of foodgrains during monsoons;
(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
(d) whether the Government has come up with innovative and techbased solutions to tackle damage to foodgrains in monsoons; and
(e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a): Food Corporation of India (FCI) procures, stores \& handles huge quantities of foodgrains. Procured foodgrains are stored in a scientific manner. Inspite of all precautionary measures, a very negligible quantity of foodgrains accrue as damaged mainly due to natural calamities viz, flood, cyclone rain etc.

The details on the quantity of foodgrains, which got damaged due to monsoon factors i.e. flood, cyclone rain etc in godowns of FCl during the last five years are as under:

| Year | Non- <br> Issuable Foodgrains Accrued ( $\ln$ LMT) | Off-take Quantity (Excluding DCP) <br> (Figures in LMT) | \% of Damaged <br> Foodgrains against Off-take Quantity <br> (Excluding DCP) |

(b) and (c): Natural calamities like floods, rains and cyclones are the main reasons for damage of foodgrains.
(d) and (e): The foodgrains procured for central pool are stored in godowns/silos which are scientifically designed.
