- a) whether the Maritime Universities which have been established in the States are being monitored directly by the Government and if so, the details thereof;
- b) the details of the funds allocated to the States by the Union Government for the purpose during the last three years and the current year; and
- c) whether the Government proposes to set up more such universities to meet the rising demand of trained personnel in the shipping sector and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) No Sir. This Ministry does not monitor or support the Maritime Universities established by the State Governments. However, Indian Maritime University (IMU), an autonomous body under the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, which have Six Campuses at Chennai, Kolkata, Kochi, Visakhapatnam, Mumbai & Navi Mumbai, is monitored by this Ministry on regular intervals.
