### SUKANYA SAMARIDDHI ACCOUNTS

#### 3327. SHRI P.C. MOHAN:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of Sukanya Samariddhi Accounts opened in Bengaluru since the inception of the scheme;
- (b) the measures taken to create awareness about the Sukanya Samariddhi Yojana among parents and guardians in Bengaluru;
- (c) whether the Government ensured the accessibility and convenience of opening Sukanya Samariddhi Accounts in Bengaluru and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the details of interest rates offered under the Sukanya Samariddhi Yojana in Bengaluru including any changes made over time; and
- (e) whether there has been any evaluation or impact assessment of the Sukanya Samariddhi Yojana in Bengaluru and if so, the details thereof along with its findings and outcomes?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

- (a) Since inception of the scheme, 3,33,228 Sukanya Samriddhi accounts have been opened in Bengaluru.
- (b) Awareness about the scheme is created by the post office officials by visiting schools, anganwadis etc, organizing melas at prominent places at regular intervals besides supplying the pamphlets and advertisement / promotion through radio jingles and social media etc.
- (c) Yes Sir, Sukanya Samriddhi accounts are opened in all the post offices in Bengaluru.
- (d) The details of interest rates offered since inception of the scheme are as follows.
