TEXTILE INFRASTRUCTURE

3338. SHRI SUBHASH CHANDRA BAHERIA:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES वस्त्र मंत्री
be pleased to state :

- (a) the details of steps taken by the Government to improve the textile infrastructure in Bhilwara along with the progress made in establishing textile parks or clusters in the region;
- (b) the details of the financial incentives, subsidies or schemes are available to textile manufacturers in Bhilwara to facilitate the adoption of modern machinery, equipment and technologies;
- (c) whether the Government is supporting and promoting the export of textiles produced in Bhilwara; and
- (d) if so, the details of the schemes, incentives or marketing initiatives aimed at boosting the export potential of the local textile industry?

(a) to (d): The Government implements policies/programmes for holistic development of all the regions of the country including Bhilwara clusters/region.

Under PowerTex India Scheme, the government had sanctioned a project under Group Workshed Scheme for Bhilwara region with a project cost of Rs. 28.83 crores. Under Amended Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme (ATUFS), since inception, a total of 116 projects (UIDs) for projects worth Rs. 1,770 crores and provisional subsidy support of Rs. 69.94 crores with employment support for more than 27949 workers over 7 years have been provided by the Government. No request for development of Textile Parks under Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks (SITP) is pending for Bhilwara, however, the details of Textile Parks sanctioned for the state of Rajasthan is as under:-

The Government also offers a number of support schemes/incentives for export promotion in the country. These schemes/incentives are applicable to the entire country including Rajasthan/Bhilwara. In order to boost export of textiles products, Government extended scheme of Rebate of State and Central Taxes and Levies (RoSCTL) on exports of Apparel/Garments and Made-ups. Further, textiles products not covered under the RoSCTL are covered under Remissions of Duties and Taxes on Exported Products (RoDTEP) along with other products. Government also provides financial support to various Export Promotion Councils and Trade Bodies engaged in promotion of textiles and garments exports, for organising and participating in trade fairs, exhibitions, buyer-seller meets etc.
